

## **Student Code of Conduct**

All students are asked to commit to and sign this Student Code of Conduct which, if followed, enables a positive and successful educational experience for each individual.

Students are expected to follow the Student Code of Conduct below, at all times, while attending Advance College:

- 1. No smoking on the premises
- 2. No spitting
- 3. No food or drink (with the exception of a resealable bottle) is to be taken into the classrooms
- 4. Do not bring alcohol, drugs or dangerous items to the program
- 5. Do not attend the program while under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- 6. Do not leave the program during participation hours without permission
- 7. Mobile phones are to be handed in to the teacher during class time
- 8. No head phones are to be worn in training rooms
- 9. Students are expected to wear clean neat casual clothes and appropriate footwear (no open toed shoes or thongs)
- 10. No hats/hoods are to be worn inside the classrooms
- 11. Do not damage equipment or furniture and respect the property and rights of others
- 12. Keep the whole program area clean and free of rubbish
- 13. Respect the rights of all students to learn, to have equal access to teacher time, resources and information
- 14. Bring a note from parents/guardians to explain absences, late arrivals or a need to leave early
- 15. Respect cultural, social, intellectual and gender differences without harassment, intimidation or bullying.
- 16. Do not run or ride bicycles, skateboards or rollerblades inside any of the buildings

In addition to the above, Advance College expects:

- A consistent demonstration of respect for, teachers, guests, other students, resources and the program environment and self.
- 2. All instructions are to be followed and all set tasks completed.
- Excellent attendance and punctuality. A student's place in the program is jeopardised by poor attendance or non-approved absence since, as a small team, we depend upon the active participation of every student, every day.
- 4. Each student to demonstrate a developing sense of personal responsibility for their words and actions. Foul language will not be tolerated.
- 5. Failure to comply with the code of conduct may result in the student being required to:
  - · attend a disciplinary interview, or
  - re-apply for their place in the program, or
  - exit the program.
